Bachelor's degree in Viticulture and Enology

Our Bachelor of Science program (<https://www.agro-bordeaux.fr/fiche-pedagogique/bachelors-degree-in-viticulture-and-enology/>) is entirely taught in English and 95 % of the students are not French. These students have the opportunity to study at the heart of one of the most prestigious wine regions in the world.

The duration of the programme is 10 months (full-time format), including a 3-month internship in a winery/vineyard.

The defining features of this degree are practical work and professional internships, as well as the prominent instructional role of practicing professionals. The teaching approach of this program will be centred on technical knowledge and professional practices.

This program is a “**Licence Professionnelle**” - French bachelor's degree program (3rd year university degree), which is internationally recognized. Such programs are ideally suited for students who seek a professional degree at the bachelor's level and are looking for immediate exposure to the business world, as well as those who want to jump-start their career.

The degree is intended for students who have completed two years of postsecondary education who want to continue and earn a bachelor's-level degree of Viticulture and Enology after 10 months of intensive additional study. Applicants should hold a completed 2nd year of undergraduate studies (U.S. associate degree of two years) in biology, chemistry, biochemistry, microbiology, fermentation and/or food sciences, agriculture, mathematical, and physical sciences.

The tuition fees are 9,000 € to be paid in three instalments.

Bordeaux Sciences Agro is a member of the **French Institute of Agronomic, Veterinary and Forest Sciences** (Agreenium) that unites the main French institutions in research and higher agronomic and veterinary education. This project, mainly carried out by Bordeaux Sciences Agro, is in partnership with other agricultural institution within Agreenium: **Montpellier Sup Agro**, **AgroSup Dijon** and **ENSAT-INP-Toulouse**. The educational value for students is in the discovery of several wine-production areas and methods of viticulture and winemaking. The development of this program will be conducted in partnership with the EPLEFPA Gironde. The different holdings of Gironde agricultural colleges (EPLEFPA) will enrich the students' technical education in addition to Château Luchey-Halde of Bordeaux Sciences Agro.

The objective of this program is to produce graduates with specific attributes:

- Become a skilled professional in the global wine industry
- Participate in projects related to international viticulture and winemaking techniques
- Provide technical advice and support to other wine industry professionals
- Acquire specific knowledge in sensory analysis

Obtaining the Bachelor's Degree in Viticulture and Enology can open doors to many different careers in this field such as:

- Winemaker
- Vineyard manager
- Technical consultancy, experimentation, control and auditing
- Managing projects for professional or public institutions and organizations
