### Entry Requirements for the Master of Engineering Degree

B.Eng or B. Tech. in Computer Sciences, Telecommunication and Networks, Software Engineering

### Minimum Entry Language Requirements

#### English

TOEFL 85 (iBT), 570 (paper), TOEIC 750, IELTS 6.5, or equivalent

#### French

**For the master's program taught in English:** basic skills needed (TEF 200, TCF 200, DELF A1 or equivalent)

**For the master's program taught in French:** TEF 600, TCF 450, DELF B2 or equivalent

### Application Deadline:

Fall semester: June 1st

### Tuition Fees

For international candidates: Two-year total of €16,000

### Financial Aid

Partial tuition waiver for high profile students

### Accommodation Allowance

International students are entitled to an accommodation allowance (APL/ALS) from the French government

For selected students with outstanding academic records
