International students in France

- ◆ 4 million students internationally mobile students in 2009
- ◆ **France is ranked 4th in the list of host countries for foreign students (259 935 foreign students in 2010) after the US, UK and Australia**
- ◆ This trend keeps increasing: between 2006 and 2010, the number of students rose of 5%.
- ◆ International students make up 12% of higher education enrollments in France

France is ranked 2nd after US for math performance
France is ranked 5th globally for the number of patents & publications
France is among the most awarded countries in Nobel prizes (45)
- National diplomas certified by french government
- International diplomas (equivalent ECTS)
- Tuition rates charged by the government

At the crossroads of Europe

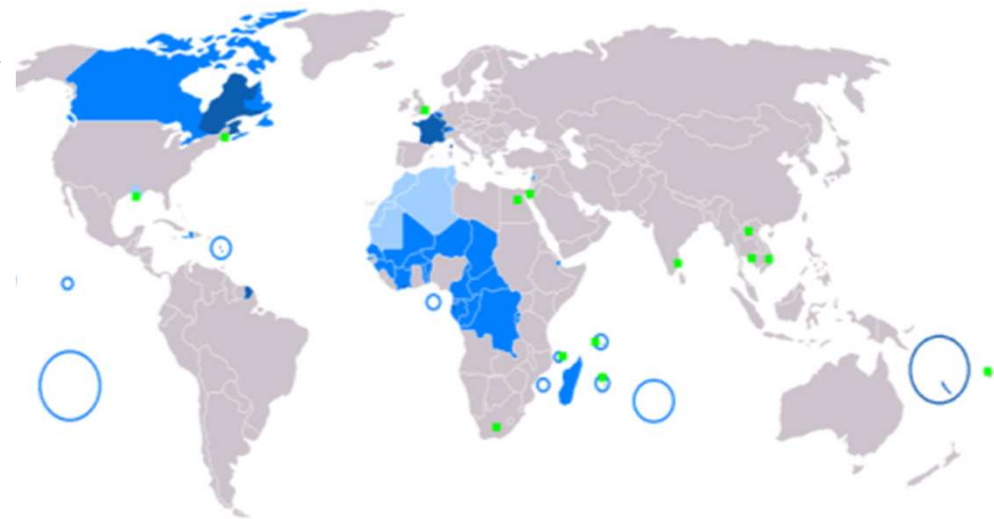
- ◆ Ideal place from which to discover Europe
